“Introduction to Picture Piecing”

The purpose of this two-day workshop is to introduce the technique of picture piecing, by using a pattern as a starting point. You may not complete your sample quilt but you will have done enough to know if this is a technique that you would like to use again. You'll be using freezer paper templates and your choice of commercial fabrics. There are no fusible products used and no raw edges. Seam lines often do not meet, adding to the abstract realism of the piece.

You will be able to purchase the pattern before the workshop so that you can begin collecting your fabrics. The cost of the pattern is \$8.50 and is in addition to the cost of the workshop.

You should bring:

- Your prepurchased pattern CONEFLOWERS.
- Freezer paper
- Colored pencils or pens, an Ultra Fine Black Sharpie and a Regular Fine Black Sharpie and paper scissors.
- Lots of fabric. See back of pattern for yardage. As noted, striated batik works great for the flower petals, but they can also be done with at least three shades (more is better) of regular fabric. The pattern cover shows flowers in shades of pink. Coneflowers are very versatile and come in many colors. Be adventurous.
- Ruler, Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Sewing Machine
- Thread in neutral color, taupe or gray.
- Basic sewing kit, scissors, seam ripper, pins, etc.
- Design wall, at least 36" square.
- Iron and ironing surface to be shared.
- You can bring your own lunch or take advantage of near by restaurants. There will be bottles water available.
